24th Annual Volunteer Doubles Challenge Tournament 2023 Tournament Rules and Regulations

FORMAT

1. A) In Center Qualifying - Teams may qualify at any participating Tennessee Bowling Center by using a three-game league score and paying a \$10 per team entry fee (\$2 local lineage, \$6 state prize money, \$2 state expenses, or by bowling a three-game set during times set by each individual center. For additional opportunities to qualify outside of league play, Please ask center manager for details.
- B) 1 of 6 teams competing at the center level advance to the State quarter-finals.
- C) State Quarter Finals - Bowlers in the State quarter-finals bowl a three-game set with the highest scoring 1 of 6 teams and ties advancing to the State semi-finals.
- D) State Semi-Finals - Bowlers in the State semi-finals will bowl a three-game set with the top 5 teams advancing to the State finals. In case of a tie for any of the top 5 spots a 9th and 10th frame roll-off, with each team receiving 20% of their handicap, will be held to determine standings. All teams advancing to the State semi-finals cash.
- E) State Finals - Finals consist of a 1 game TV style roll-off with the winning team advancing to the next match. (5th bowls 4th with winner bowling 3rd etc.) In case of a tie a 9th and 10th frame roll-off, with each team receiving 20% of their handicap, will be held.

DATES

2. A) **In Center Qualifying** – November 7, 2022 – March 24, 2023
- B) **State Quarter Finals** – April 15th, April 16th, April 22nd, 2023 @ Hermitage Strike & Spare
- C) **State Semi-Finals** – April 23rd, 2023 @ Hermitage Strike & Spare
- D) **State Finals** – April 23rd, 2023 @ 9:00 AM immediately following the State Semi-Finals – at Hermitage Strike & Spare

ELIGIBILITY

3. A) Participation is open to any adult league bowler at any participating Tennessee Bowling Center who is 18 years of age or older.
- B) Participants must be a league bowler and have a minimum of 21 games toward a league average.
- C) Entrant may not be a member of any professional bowling association. (PBA, PWBA, or any group the Committee considers professional)
- D) Entrants may not be a member of USBC Youth.
- E) Any entry may be refused for any reason by the Tournament Committee.

TEAM COMPOSITION

4. A) Teams may be composed of 1 man & 1 woman, 2 men, or 2 women as long as eligibility requirements in rules 3.A) thru 3.F) are met.

AVERAGES

5. A) The average used for in-house competition shall be the highest current 2022-2023 league average of at least 21 games at time of entry. Bowlers without at least a 21-game average must bowl scratch (225).
- B) The average used for bowlers who advance to State Quarter Finals, Semi-Finals, and Finals shall be the highest current 2022-2023 league average of at least 21 games as of April 1, 2023, or the average with which they qualified, whichever is higher. Bowlers without at least 21 games as of April 1, 2023, must bowl scratch (225). Each bowler who advances to the State semi-finals is required to bring an average verification form signed by the tournament coordinator of the center in which they qualified.

HANDICAP

6. A) The team handicap at all levels of competition is 90% of 450.

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION

7. A) Multiple participation is permitted for individuals and teams at the house level...however, the same team may qualify only once for the State Quarter Finals.
- B) A bowler may qualify for the State Quarter Finals a maximum of four (4) times with different partners.

GENERAL PLAYING RULES

8. A) This tournament is administered through a Tournament Director appointed by the Tournament Committee.
- B) Any matters not covered by these rules are decided upon by the Tournament Director and/or the Tournament Committee and all decisions are final.
- C) This tournament is conducted in accordance with the general playing rules of the United States Bowling Congress where the above rules are not specified.
