

➤ **What is the Volunteer Doubles Challenge Tournament:**

- **An inexpensive tournament with in-center, in-league qualifying that provides a fun format for your adult league bowlers (age 18 and up).**
- **Participants pick their partner, enter their league scores on the entry form and turn them in to the front desk at the conclusion of their league.**
- **One out of every six teams will advance to the state quarterfinals and have the opportunity to become the state champion!**

➤ **Who is eligible to host this tournament?**

Bowling centers that are members of the Tennessee BPA are eligible to host a qualifying event.

➤ **Why would I want to host this event?**

- **No cost for you other than your time! Collect the entry form, fees, and scores each league night. Complete the advancer report at the end of the qualifying window and sent the report and state fees (\$48 per team) to the Tennessee BPA by March 31, 2023, to enter your teams.**
- **The center earns \$2.00 per entry that you can use at your discretion. Some examples for use of your \$2.00:**
 - **Revenue for your center – just put it in your cash register. Everyone could use the additional revenue – right?**
 - **Be a HERO and use the \$2.00 to give back to your league bowlers that participate! Not all teams will advance to the state quarterfinals, so use the money to create your own prize money distribution in-house. Your participants will appreciate your engagement with them and remember how you GAVE BACK!**
 - **Donate the money to your favorite charity or even your youth league scholarship fund.**
- **As a participating member center, you can earn additional money by running out-of-league qualifying events during your slow time. You can create your own qualifying event outside the league environment using the same format.**
 - **Three games of bowling**
 - **Charge lineage for this event plus the additional \$8.00 for the state fees**
 - **Run as many qualifying events as you want from November 7, 2022 – March 24, 2023, and generate significant lineage for your center**
- **You can provide your league bowlers with an opportunity that NO non-member center can extend to their customers! Your leagues will appreciate your efforts and rewards you in ways that will generate additional revenue for your center.**

➤ ***What is my time investment to run this event?***

- You decide how to deliver this event to your league bowlers and how much time you spend on the event is your decision. Many centers go the EXTRA MILE for their league bowlers and post standings weekly, advertise the event in their announcements before league play every night on every shift, develop an in-house prize money list, and many more great ideas for promotion of the event.
- Your minimum time investment is outlined below:
 - Your desk clerk can collect the forms and fees for in-league qualifying and put them in a designated location for your manager or on-site event coordinator nightly – *minutes per shift*.
 - Your event coordinator or designated individual would hold the forms until the end of the qualifying window and based on scores, would complete the advancer form – *based on number of advancing teams could take 10 minutes per entry*.
 - Generate the check for payment of state fees (\$48 per advancing team) – *minutes*.
 - Mail your advancer packet to be received by the state tournament director by March 31, 2023 – minutes.

Please consider hosting this event for the 2022-2023 qualifying window November 7, 2022 – March 24, 2023! Your league bowlers will appreciate you for it and you will benefit from the revenue generated at your center.
